Parking Lot Policies and Procedures

1. Qualified Parking on campus requires a completed application and the purchase of a parking permit. Parking permits can be purchased at the bookstore. Note: Parking permits are issued on a first come first serve basis.
2. All parking stickers must be visibly applied to the inside of the front left windshield (Security must be able to read the number on the parking pass and decal).
3. Students must park in the west parking lot. Students are not permitted to park in the bus loop or the east parking lot.
4. Students must park front-in, no back-in parking is allowed.
5. As in any parking lot, vehicles are parked at the owner's risk. The District and/or Verrado High School are not responsible for theft or damage to the vehicle.
6. For your security, upon arrival, lock your car and proceed onto school grounds. (LOITERING IN THE PARKING LOT IS PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES)
7. Students must have permission from administration to access their cars during the school day.
8. Maximum speed limit on campus is 5 MPH. Any student who drives recklessly or uses excessive speed in the school zone, this includes Indian School Road, Pioneer Street, and the east/west parking lot, will have their driving privileges restricted or revoked.
9. Vehicles without proper parking permits will be subject to towing at the student's/owner's expense.
10. If your permit is lost or stolen, replacement permits are \$10.00 and can be purchased at the Bookstore.
11. Parking permits will be revoked if any signature(s) is forged.
12. Temporary Registration Plates for newly purchased vehicles are allowed for 30 days only. Permanent plate information must be updated at the bookstore immediately.
13. If your vehicle has out of state plates, you must provide proof of active duty status; otherwise Arizona Department of Transportation requires that you make current your registration information immediately.
14. Parking at the school is a privilege that must not be abused. Any student who abuses the parking rules and regulations may have privileges restricted or revoked by administration at any time. (This may include the car being removed at the student's/owner's expense).

By signing below I have read and understand the parking procedures. I also understand the failure to follow any of the above rules may result in the revocation of my parking privileges or the towing of my vehicle at my expense. I agree that the Agua Fria High School District and Verrado High School assume no responsibility for any damage or theft of personal property which may occur while the vehicle is parked in the parking lot.
