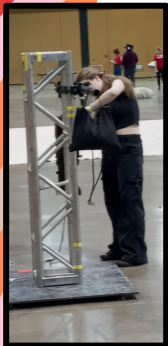



Stage Management

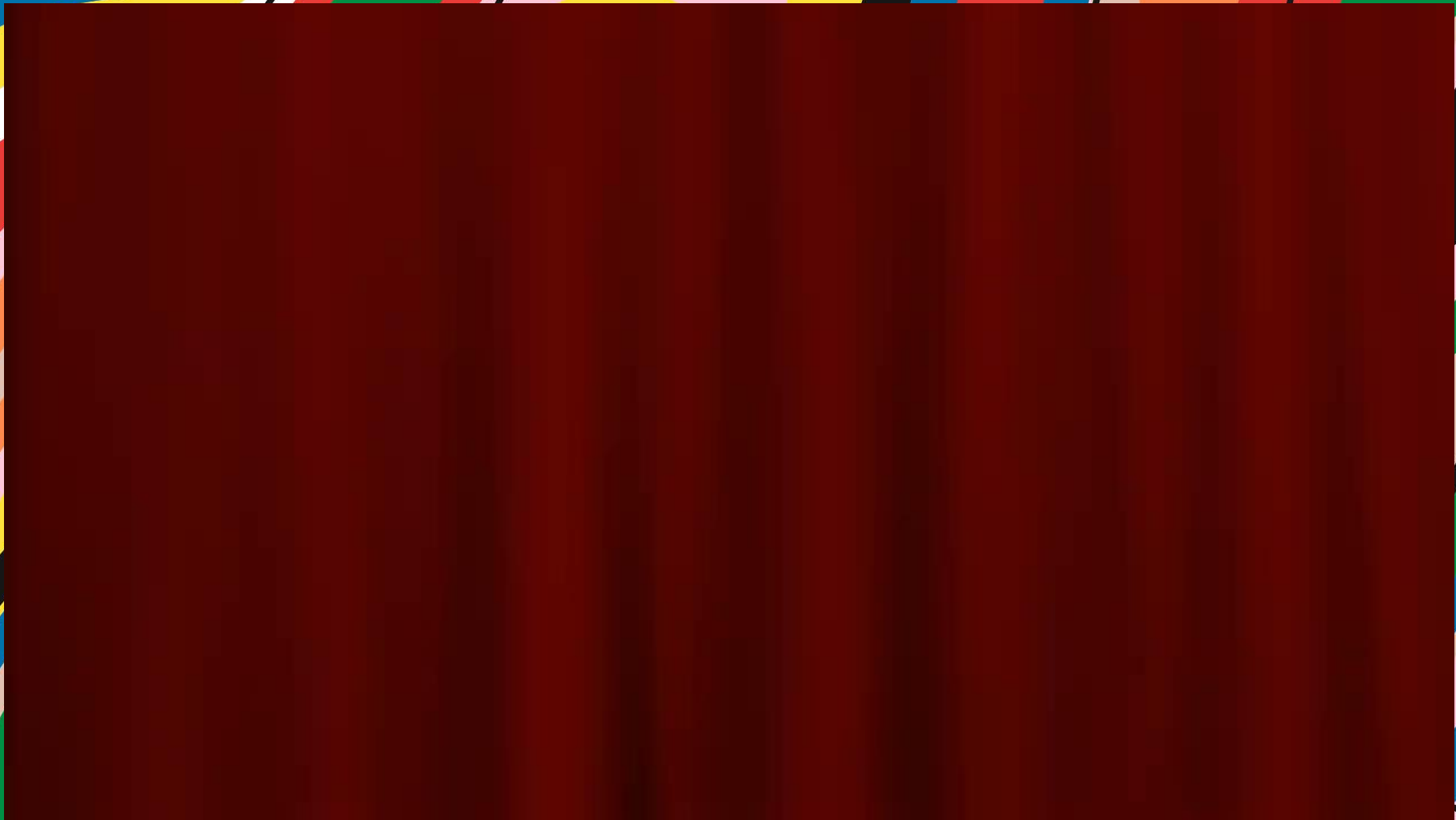
Learn the art of organizing and coordinating all aspects of a production to ensure a smooth and seamless performance.
