Program Information

A Master Degree in Educational Leadership with Principal Certification from NAU is perfect for working teachers looking to advance their careers. This program-prepares teachers to serve as a K-12 principal or school administrator. The program also includes a 6 month internship in a school where participants will apply what they have learned in their courses. The internship can be completed at the teacher's school, and they will work with a principal and an NAU internship faculty member.

- 36 credits/12 classes total.
- Online courses offered in 7.5- week sessions
- Courses are taught by NAU faculty with school administrator work experience.
- Program designed to be completed in two years.
- NAU issues an Institutional Recommendation (IR) to provide to the state to apply for principal certification.
- This program is accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP)
- This program is aligned to the National Educational Leadership Preparation standards.

Admission Requirements

- NAU Graduate Online application.
- Undergraduate degree from a regionally accredited institution.
- Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.00 (scale is 4.00 = "A"), or the equivalent.
 Conditional admission may be granted with a GPA below 3.0.
- No Program Fees, No GRE, and No Recommenders needed.
- Teaching Certificate (standard or provisional).
- Must have 3 years of teaching experience to enroll in the internship (the internship is completed at the end of the program).
